Training Director's Message:

Feeling Stressed? Half the year is gone. The to-do list is increasing rather than decreasing. There is a feeling that nothing you do truly matters; no one cares if you show up to events, instruct

or assist with classes, on committees. I completely understand. There are days you want to run screaming from the building. So why has this club survived 50 years? It's the little things that matter.

What a cliché. It's the little things in life that matters. Pause and think about that for a moment. Pause and think about that member that had an impact on your life. Think about that moment you impacted another member, student – human or dog.

Over the years I have two moments during training classes that keep me going and believing it is possible to make a difference and I want to share one. Several years ago, a little girl had snarky Miniature Schnauzer. It wasn't a class I had signed up to instruct or assist, but the instructor asked me if I would help this girl during class. It was obvious the girl loved this little dog. She was shy, the only child in a room full of adults, and her furry friend was telling everyone to go away. Every week she worked so hard, and every week she needed encouraging words to keep working and pointing out where the small improvements were apparent when she was so close to tears. At the end of the 8 weeks (yes this was a long time ago) when the instructor was putting the class through the exercises and having the students show their tricks, I don't remember the trick that was performed but what I do remember is a little girl that was not in tears because she had a snarky Miniature Schnauzer. She had the brightest smile on her face because her dog performed a trick and people could pet her dog. Not only did the dog learn some manners but the girl grew from shy and timid to strong and confident.

We might not see those moments in every class. Those moments might not end as this moment. Honestly, I thought I would show up once or twice and work with that girl and then leave. I would have missed out on something that has impacted how I feel about dog training and helping in classes. Yes, life is stressful. Yes, if you give your time to helping others train it does take away from the time you can spend training your dogs and working toward your goals. Yet I want to encourage you to leave time for possibilities that saying yes to helping others might give you a moment that will provide encouragement to you in ways you never imagined.


